This is to help ensure that during your time at Webber International University, you continue to keep your chronic conditions well-controlled and have close follow-up for exacerbations.
- Urgent consultative options are also available for skin conditions, cough, colds and flu, infections, injuries, and more.
- We understand that your sexual health and gynecologic care is also important.
 Confidential exams can be performed when needed and screening can be
 performed for sexually transmitted infections. Contraceptive management
 options can be discussed, if desired. Pap smears should be performed in
 women starting at 21 years old regardless of sexual activity.
- Care is also available for faculty and staff of Webber International University, which is on a fee-for-service basis.
