

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
WEBBER INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY
AND
VALENCIA COLLEGE**

This agreement is entered into between Webber International University (Webber) and Valencia College (Valencia)

WHEREAS, the parties desire to coordinate curricula so as to assist students in transferring from Valencia to Webber, and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to promote the most efficient and effective use of their resources, and to offer students the broadest possible range of educational opportunities, and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to encourage and facilitate the establishment of specific articulation provisions between Webber and Valencia.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties, through this document and institutional addenda, agree to cooperate in articulating programs in accordance with the terms set forth herein.

Webber shall recognize the Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS) and Bachelor of Science (BS) as the transfer degree from Valencia.

- I. Webber shall specify and publish the programs articulated with the Associate and Bachelor of Science Degrees.
- II. Webber shall specify and publish the program requirements and related prerequisite courses aligned with the Florida state university system for each program listed under Exhibit A.
- III. Webber shall consider General Education Requirements met for students with a Valencia AA or AS degree and develop a program career pathway for degree programs with all general education courses accepted toward meeting Webber's general education requirements.
- IV. Webber and Valencia shall agree to the following conditions:
 - A. Valencia students who transfer with an AA or AS degree under the terms of this agreement shall enter Webber with junior standing.
 - B. Courses taken by a Valencia student transferring under the terms of this agreement shall be given every consideration for optimal transfer using the catalog of initial entrance to Valencia. A student will have the option to follow the current catalog, however. A student must have maintained continuous full time enrollment as defined by Webber, i.e., 12 credit hours in fall and spring semester, respectively, or part time enrollment at 50% course load each term, and the transfer must be direct from Valencia to Webber.

- C. Admission of a new Valencia student to Webber will depend on the continuation of the program at Webber. Program discontinuance will remove any obligation of Webber to comply with the provisions of the Articulation Agreement relative to the discontinued program. Valencia students already enrolled in a Webber program will be permitted to complete that program.
- D. The grade of "D," will neither transfer nor count toward the Baccalaureate degree unless it was earned within a completed Associate's degree.
- E. Webber shall accept Valencia graduates with AA or AS degrees with up to 69 credits to be transferred and applied towards the awarding of a Baccalaureate Degree. However, the student must meet the specific degree course requirements of Webber, which may mean extending the number of credit hours to earn the degree, if the 69 hours transferred and applied do not include all of the degree prerequisites.
- F. Webber Institutional Scholarships are available to Valencia graduates:
 - 1. Academic Scholarships are available to full time students in AA or AS programs who have a cumulative GPA of a 3.00 or higher. An additional \$1,000 yearly scholarship is available to students entering Webber through this agreement.
 - 2. Students entering Webber under this agreement who will be a member of a Webber athletic team will be awarded athletic scholarship at the discretion of the appropriate team coach. Academic Scholarship for athletes may be included.
 - 3. Valencia students who apply to Webber's adult program are not eligible for the Webber scholarship opportunities since the program already has reduced tuition.
- G. Only courses taken at Webber will be used in compiling a student's cumulative grade point average and Webber may specify the grade point average required for graduation. Admission to Webber major fields of study will be based on Valencia students incoming GPA's.
- H. Authority over all academic policies or practices not mentioned in this agreement shall remain with the institution at which the student is enrolled.
- I. Programmatically, the forgiveness policy for Webber shall prevail, except that the GPA calculated by Valencia for the awarding of an Associate's Degree shall be the GPA used to determine admission into the program.

VI. During the period of this agreement, Valencia shall:

- A. Publicize the articulation agreement among the faculty, staff, and students at Valencia.
- B. Make available to Valencia faculty members, counselors, students, and other appropriate individuals at Valencia, Webber's admission requirements; course program requirements;

program prerequisite courses, other related requirements, and the course equivalency lists.

- C. Coordinate with Webber's Director of Admissions and staff to initiate and facilitate information sessions at Valencia for students.

VII. During the period of this agreement, Webber shall:

- A. Refer Webber students to Valencia for enrollment in courses not offered by Webber during a specific term.
- B. Conduct a campus tour day for Valencia students at least once each semester coordinated through the Curriculum Coordinator.
- C. Provide matriculation data to Valencia. Within year one provide a report to the Curriculum Coordinator at Valencia on the number of students matriculated and the program areas in which students matriculate at Webber. Annually or as requested for reporting purposes provide additional reports during the term of this Agreement to the Curriculum Coordinator at Valencia.

VIII. Both parties agree:

- A. To review the Articulation Agreement annually. The Curriculum Coordinator at Valencia will initiate the review.
- B. To cooperate on curricular changes that will facilitate future student transfer.
- C. To exercise best efforts in exploring and developing mutually beneficial financial aid programs for students directly affected by this agreement.
- D. To review instances of student transfer and admissions difficulties and recommend appropriate solutions.
- E. To recommend the resolution of issues and policies which will improve articulation between the institutions.
- F. To grant the right to use the college's name and logo in writing for purposes of this agreement only and only upon prior approval by Webber and Valencia for each use.

IX. Articulation Agreement.

- A. The Articulation Agreement shall be in effect until terminated.
- B. Proposed modifications, additions, or deletions to the Articulation Agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.

- C. Termination of the Articulation Agreement must be submitted with 30-day notice, in writing, to either party. The termination will be in effect beginning with the following Fall term. Webber shall abide by the terms and conditions of the Articulation Agreement with respect to all students who were enrolled in Webber on or before the effective date of termination, except in regards to terminated programs.
- D. Any modifications, additions, or deletions to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.

THIS AGREEMENT shall take effect on the last date signed below and shall remain in effect until terminated by either party.


