- Master's degree or higher in Elementary Education, Curriculum and Instruction, or Administration and Supervision plus at least 18 graduate hours in elementary education.
- Minimum of 3 years teaching experience in the PK – 12 classroom or school administration.

- Ability to use technology in creating and delivering course content.
- Demonstrated depth of knowledge in the subject area to be taught and currency in the discipline.
